Both forums focused strongly on increasing implementation of the SDGs, including scaling up successful practices through knowledge sharing. The Urban SDG Knowledge Platform, co-developed by CityNet, Seoul Metropolitan Government (SMG), and United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) is an open-access database on various SDG policies and implementations at a local level.



ON LOCALIZATION OF URBAN PRACTICES

The biggest challenge for cities pursuing sustainable development is the implementation of best practices into their cities. The Toolkit on Localization of Urban Practices is a pre-feasibility study screening tool that aims to assess if best practices and projects from one city can be localized and implemented into another city. Based on a self-assessment of five key dimensions, cities wil be able to assess whether the target practice is suitable to be adapted and localized, considering their specific context.
